The feature Artist of the month is
Dr. Don Crumb.

After forty-five years as a successful dentist in
Syracuse, New York, Dr. Don Crumb is now retired
and focusing his attention on the art of photography.

He states "As a photographer I focus on nature's
landscapes and wildlife. Each of us has a unique
perspective on our view of nature. I aspire to share
my vision of nature with others through my
photographs and thus, in some small way, evoke a
sense of passion and appreciation of the natural
beauty around us".

Dr. Crumb, a self-taught photographer for many
years, started with film and now works exclusively
with digital imaging. While many of his photographs
were taken in our National Parks across the United
States, he also enjoys capturing images locally and in
New York State including the Adirondacks. It is a
common site to see Don with his camera
photographing flowers, songbirds, whitetail deer and
fox in his Camillus neighborhood.

You may have seen some of his award-winning
photographs at the New York State Fair in recent
years. Don was also privileged to have been the
Grand Prize winner in the 2017 Nikon and Princess
Cruises International Photo Contest for his
photograph "Polychrome Pass" taken in Denali
National Park. Now that he has his own business,
Don Crumb Photography, he prints and sells his
