### Ellen Gill

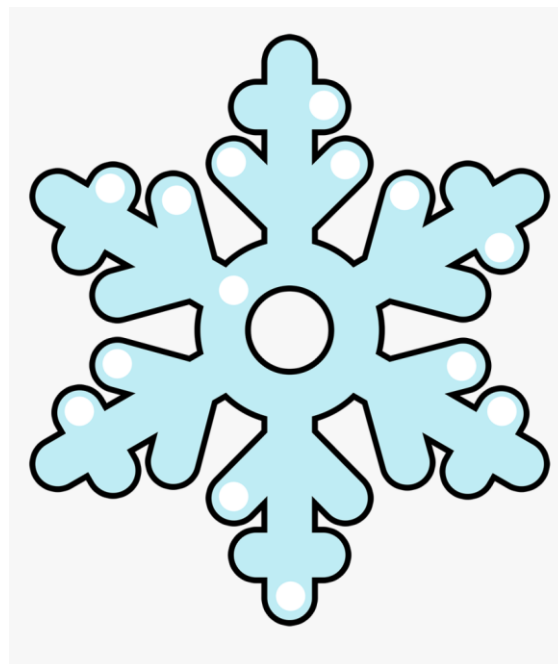
